Peer Support:

Other Agency Programs

State Care Coordination: Links individuals pre-and post-release from Residential treatment with services necessary to maintain recovery.

Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program: Available to children & adults currently enrolled in Behavioral Health treatment. Focuses on treatment to improve life skills.

START Program: Provides support, referrals, planning, and education for individuals at high risk of a Behavioral Health crisis.

Mental Health Case Management: Serves our adult population by providing them resources for basic needs (ie housing, employment, food).

Overdose Prevention: Available to any member of the community interested in receiving the training and education needed to identify an overdose and administer Narcan.

Re-Entry & Recovery: Links individuals pre-and post-release from the Worcester County. Detention Center to appropriate services in the community.
