CT Studies

- 1. Contrast Terminology
 - a. Without contrast: No preparation required
 - b. With contrast: refers only to intravenous (IV) contrast, not oral contrast. Oral contrast will be administered unless the order states otherwise.
- 2. General Patient Preparation
 - a. No contrast: no preparation required
 - b. Oral contrast only:
 - i. Patients need to pick up the barium *prior* to the study in the Rediscripts Pharmacy
 - ii. Patients will be given 1 bottle of oral contrast 90 minutes before the study
 - iii. No blood work is required
 - c. Intravenous (IV) contrast exams:
 - i. Do not eat solid foods for 3 hours before the intravenous contrast injection
 - ii. Blood work (creatinine eGfr within 30 days) is required if over 60 years of age, diabetic, or have history of kidney disease.
