Presidents' Letter

As we approach the final weeks of 2021, it is important for us to reflect on all of the challenges we have faced as a community, and recognize the magnitude of our strength when we come together as a whole.

With a lingering pandemic that has brought new waves of COVID infection and hospitalization, this year has not been easy. But even through these immensely difficult times, the community has illuminated bright spots of unmatched compassion, empathy and – most importantly – unity.

We are proud to be your care.givers.

This COVID-19 pandemic has given Atlantic General Hospital and Health Systems the opportunity to closely observe and analyze the needs of those we serve. This insight allowed us to make necessary changes in order to better provide accessible, high-quality care to those who need it most. Whether modifying existing services or instituting new initiatives, every move we make as an organization revolves around one thing: the health and well-being of our community.

Our dedicated staff has been on the forefront of the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic, and we have witnessed first-hand the devastating effects of the illness. While the physical complications associated with the virus are obvious to most, the less tangible implications of this pandemic can be overlooked: deteriorating mental health

Fear, grief and isolation have reached extraordinary levels due to COVID-19, and the negative effects associated with enduring these stressors long-term have become apparent. According to the National Institute of Mental Health, a CDC survey from June 2020 reported, "31% of respondents reported symptoms of anxiety or depression, 13% reported having started or increased substance use, 26% reported stress-related symptoms, and 11% reported having serious thoughts of suicide in the past 30 days."

This is layered on top of the already-high incidence of depression and anxiety and other mental health illness that existed in prepandemic years.

Taking the necessary steps to address mental health issues can be an intimidating and stressful experience. In June of this year, we implemented an innovative integrated behavioral health program in our primary care offices to ease the process as much as we can.

With the launch of the new program, it is now possible to schedule video visits with our behavioral health specialists right from any one of our many primary care offices. That means patients of our provider practices in Ocean View, DE or Pocomoke, MD no longer have to travel the extra miles to our Behavioral Health Center in Berlin. A therapy session or medication check-up is just a button-click away.

In January 2022, our Behavioral Health Center will begin providing walkin services to those in acute distress. Our trained specialists will provide immediate care for these patients, facilitating the transfer to higher levels of care or connecting them, as needed, to community

With the goal of providing accessible, optimized health care in mind,

We are working towards finalizing arrangements for the construction of the

Gudelsky Family Medical Center, which will provide multispecialty outpatient surgery. We would like to thank the Gudelsky family and all Campaign for the Future donors for making this project a reality. And, to all of our donors: We could not do what we do every day without you. Thank you!

As the tumultuous year of 2021 comes to a close, we would also like to take this opportunity to recognize and express our sincere gratitude for our associates and medical staff. Their hard work, dedication and commitment to serving our community throughout this pandemic has been nothing short of incredible. Thus far, our staff has treated more than 500 COVID-positive inpatients and administered more than 12,600 doses of COVID-19 vaccines. Their selfless service has had a direct impact on moving us forward through this pandemic, and we are truly grateful.

New Gudelsky Family Medical Center

to bring expanded outpatient services

to the community

The Gudelsky Family Medical Center will allow for expansion of surgical services available in Worcester County, while also providing a more cost-effective location for planned outpatient procedures.

- Three procedure rooms and one surgery suite will be shifted from the surgery department within Atlantic General Hospital to the new Center, built larger to accommodate the equipment, instrumentation and sterile field zones required for today's more complex procedures. The Center will also house an additional operating room.
- Construction will incorporate best practice and progressive surgical planning strategies, including improved lighting, a variety of private and semi-private pre- and post-operative patient care stations, plus discharge areas responding to the specific needs of patients.
- The Center will not be subject to rate regulation by the state of Maryland, and Atlantic General Hospital and Health System will be able to provide needed services in a less costly environment. This means that patients who are restricted to stand-alone surgery centers by their health insurance plans will now have a cost-effective option for their care close to home. Until the Gudelsky Family Medical Center opens, patients must either forgo care due to inconvenience, or undertake traveling 20 miles or further to obtain these services.



 The shift to providing sameday surgery outside the hospital campus will allow for enlargement of the three remaining suites in the hospital to better accommodate laparoscopic surgery and other advanced procedures.

Children ages 5 - 11 can now get a COVID-19 Vaccine

In early November, The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine for children ages 5 to 11 years. Now that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has recommended its use, kids in this age group can start getting shots right away. Here are some key questions and answers about the COVID-19 vaccine for younger kids.

Does it work?

Yes. The Pfizer vaccine is nearly 91% effective in preventing COVID-19 in young children. This is similar to adult vaccines.

Is the dose different?

Yes. It is one-third the adult dose. (By the way, providers also use smaller needles to give this vaccine.)

How many shots do kids need?

Kids need two doses (three weeks apart) for full protection.

Is the vaccine safe?

It is. The Pfizer vaccine was studied in more than 3,000 children and found to be safe. The FDA OK'd the vaccine for emergency use in younger kids after concluding that the benefits of the vaccine outweigh the known and potential risks.

Are there any side effects?

Some kids have no side effects. Others may have mild side effects that last one or two days. The most common reactions include a sore arm, tiredness or a headache. This is normal. Serious side effects (such as severe allergic reactions) are rare with COVID-19 vaccines. No children ages 5 to 11 in the vaccine trial had a serious side effect.

Why should kids get the vaccine?

- It protects their health. Although COVID-19 is often more serious in adults than in children, kids can get very sick. About 1.9 million kids between ages 5 and 11 have been infected since the start of the pandemic, the American Academy of Pediatrics reports. Of these, more than 8,300 have been hospitalized, and 94 have died.
- It helps keep them in school and social activities that have been disrupted by the pandemic. Such activities are important to children's education and emotional well-being.
- It slows the spread of COVID-19 to families and communities.

When and where can kids get the shot?

The vaccine is readily available in our community. Local pharmacies have added pediatric appointments for the vaccine and the local health departments and Atlantic General Hospital are offering clinics near you. Visit **www.agh.care/vaccine** for the latest information about upcoming clinics.

How can I learn more?

Please talk with your child's healthcare provider if you have questions or concerns about the vaccine. You can also access links to information from the CDC by visiting www.agh.care/vaccine.

Video Visits

Also offered are video visits with our behavioral health specialists, held right in your primary care provider's office.

Thanks to new communications technology plus our integrated behavioral health services program, you don't have to travel the extra miles to receive care at our behavioral health center in Berlin. Instead, if your primary care provider is part of Atlantic General Health System, you can take advantage of this important and valuable service.

Here's how the video visits program works:

• If you are a new patient, please call the Atlantic General Behavioral Health Center at 410-641-3340. They will assist you with booking your initial appointment with board certified Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner Diane Skolka, and collecting any necessary information for our records.

- On the date of your appointment, go to your AGHS primary care provider's office 15 minutes prior to your appointment time.
- The staff will escort you to the office's telehealth room and set up the video connection for your private consultation with Diane Skolka.
- For future visits, you will schedule your behavioral health appointments through the front desk at your primary care provider's office. These video visits are covered by most insurances – just like an in-person appointment.

This program is funded in part through support from the Rural Maryland Council.



Walk-in Behavioral Health for Individuals in Crisis

Beginning in January 2022, a new walk-in service for individuals in acute distress will be offered at Atlantic General's Behavioral Health Center, through the TRIBE partnership. It will include:

- An initial assessment by a nurse and social worker, with therapy sessions available
- Tele-visits with mental health specialists, as needed
- Real-time connection with needed resources, provided by agencies located onsite
- Transfers to a higher level of care, if needed
- Insurance and financial counseling services available for uninsured or under-insured patients.

What is TRIBE?

TRIBE stands for **Tri-County Behavioral Health Engagement** – a newly formed regional partnership between Atlantic General Hospital, TidalHealth Peninsula Regional, plus nine behavioral health community partner agencies with the mission to provide behavioral health urgent care centers or crisis stabilization centers to the community.

Diane's philosophy is based on facilitating positive personal change and growth. She incorporates a "whole person" approach to care with respect to the mind-body connection.

Diane joined Atlantic General Health System in November 2020 to provide psychiatric and behavioral health care to adult patients. Prior to becoming a nurse practitioner, Diane had 19 years of experience as a registered nurse. She has a background in Critical Care/Post Anesthesia Care in addition to her role as a Patient Care Coordinator in Case Management/Population Health. Diane earned her bachelor's degree in nursing at Wilmington University and her master's degree in PMHNP studies at Eastern Kentucky University.

2021 STRATEGIC INITIATIVES: CONTINUING PROGRESS on Multiple Fronts

Noteworthy initiatives that were undertaken in Fiscal Year 2021 addressed several key strategic priorities.

Primary Care Behavioral Health

Approximately half of all patients seeking primary care are dealing with an underlying mental health condition that is either contributing to or complicating a physical illness. In fact, 60% of behavioral health illnesses are treated in primary care. Implementing an integrated behavioral health model increases access to behavioral health services and helps neutralize objections to care related to the stigma associated with mental illness.

Through the use of telehealth technology, the integrated behavioral health program at Atlantic General is allowing patients to receive the care they need right in their primary care doctor's office. Embedding this service in the primary care office allows providers to refer patients with an acute behavioral health concern for same-day care. It also makes it easier for individuals who live in southern Worcester County or in Sussex County to access the care they need without undertaking additional travel to Berlin, where the Behavioral Health Center is located. This program launched in June 2021.

Mobile Integrated Community Health

As much as every patient's health concern is valid, non-urgent calls to 911 often result in a strain on EMS crews — and expensive treatment for patients who could be better cared for in a different setting.

In fiscal year 2021, Atlantic General completed work with Worcester County EMS, Worcester Commission on Aging, Veterans Affairs, local police departments and Worcester County Health Department to develop a mobile integrated health unit that provides a home assessment for individuals who frequently make non-

urgent calls to 911, in order to coordinate care and connect them with appropriate community resources and to help them attain optimal quality of life while remaining at home.

Most of the interventions to-date are related to transportation, medication, and addressing safety concerns. The program continues as the participating agencies seek additional grants and a sustainable funding model.

Infectious Disease Surveillance Program

Until blood samples and lab cultures are analyzed – which typically takes several hours – a patient's care team must rely on symptoms and patient history to determine the immediate course of treatment. But with the help of infectious disease surveillance technology, those results can now be delivered electronically to the attending physician within seconds of being generated. This shortens the response time for properly isolating any patient found to have a contagious infection, and it also allows the physician to fine-tune medication therapies. This also helps reduce the risk of hospital-acquired infections and strengthens AGH's antibiotic stewardship efforts.

Additionally, the technology makes it easier to detect and analyze trends in hospital-acquired infections that can sometimes be missed with a traditional manual process, thereby making quality improvement efforts more effective and successful.

The Infectious Disease Surveillance Program is expected to be in place and fully operational by the end of the 2021 calendar year.

Underscore Our Continuing Commitment to Community Health

Ambient Technology

With the implementation of "ambient technology" in physician practices - electronic environments that are sensitive and responsive to the presence of people - providers will be freed from copious documentation currently required on their computers. While documentation is necessary to accurately capture medical histories and current issues that patients may be verbally describing, computer use can seem intrusive—and sometimes even interfere with the patient-provider connection. Secure, private audio devices with language recognition technology will soon replace the bulk of the typed notes entered into a patient's record.

For patients, this means more time having a natural, meaningful exchange with their provider. It also means less time waiting in the exam room as providers finish documentation before seeing their next patient, as well as freeing up more appointment times. For healthcare providers, it means taking the heavy load of computer documentation off their shoulders, resulting in better job satisfaction and an improved work/life balance.

Osteoporosis Clinic

Osteoporosis affects approximately 5.3 million adults aged 50 years and older in the United States – and as the population ages this is predicted to increase by as much as 50% by 2025. A disability related to osteoporosis impacts quality of life, and restricts activities of

daily living as well as the ability to work. Barriers to appropriate prevention and intervention further complicate efforts to treat this clinically silent condition.

The development of an osteoporosis clinic for mature adults who are identified as high risk for falls and fractures is continuing from Fiscal Year 2021. Creating an osteoporosis clinic will provide multiple services in one setting that patients can access during a single visit. The clinic's services will encompass risk assessment, bone densitometry, primary and specialty care provider collaboration, multidisciplinary treatment plans, and nutrition and fall prevention programs.

Mobile Patient Experience

With our already-fast pace of life getting even faster, juggling daily aspects of work and home life can be challenging for many people. Research shows that a smartphone is in almost everyone's pocket – and many people have used that technology to help make managing their health and keeping up with medical care activities a little easier.

Over the past 12 months, AGH has enhanced the mobile patient experience so that people can receive text reminders for appointments, cancel or reschedule appointments, receive discharge instructions and care summaries, and stay connected after an inpatient stay so that the care team can intervene quickly to keep patients on the path to recovery - all via direct message. And, there's no

need to register for a FolllowMyHealth patient portal account.

This strategic initiative is continuing into 2022. Starting this fall, all Atlantic General Health System patients will have the option to text their doctor's office with a request to be placed on a waitlist for an earlier appointment time. Additionally, once they have arrived for their appointment, they can check in on their mobile phone, verify their insurance information on record, and process any co-pays needed - right from their phone.

School-Based Telehealth

This initiative, originally begun in Fiscal Year 2020, continues into the new fiscal year as delays due to the global COVID-19 pandemic have interrupted school operations. A large number of residents in southern Worcester County – Pocomoke City in particular – face multiple barriers to appropriate health care due to factors such as cost, the lack of transportation and a dearth of health care providers. Schoolbased telemedicine is crucial to the Pocomoke High School population. Immediate access to such resources will improve the health of the student body as well as overall attendance and academic outcomes.

Activities continue with the Worcester County Public Schools to bring this initiative to fruition at Pocomoke High School – with an anticipated launch on or before January 2022.





data management, interoperability/ population health, patient engagement, and clinical quality/safety).

Allergies? ... or COVID?

Here's how to tell them apart.

In the past, when allergies flared up you might have blamed ragweed or mold. But these days, you have another possibility to think about. Could it be COVID-19?

The fact is, COVID-19 and allergies can have similar symptoms. But there are a few ways to tell the two apart.

How they may be similar ...

- A runny or stuffy nose, headache, and fatigue can occur with both allergies and COVID-19.
- People with allergies sometimes have asthma, too. If so, their allergies may trigger COVID-like symptoms such as coughing, wheezing, chest tightness and shortness of breath.
- Some people with allergies can even seem to lose their sense of taste or smell – another classic COVID-19 symptom – due to a stuffy nose.

How they're different ...

Some allergy symptoms rarely, if ever, occur with COVID-19. So they can give you important clues as to what's going on. For instance, you're more likely to be dealing with allergies if you have:

- Sneezing
- Itchy, watery eyes
- An itch in your nose, on the roof of your mouth, or in your throat

Likewise, according to information from the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America, the following COVID-19 symptoms typically do not occur with allergies:

- Fever
- Chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Upset stomach
- Diarrhea

Of course, it's always a good idea to contact your doctor if you have any COVID-19 symptoms (especially a fever or cough), or any other symptoms that concern you. You may need to take a COVID-19 test to rule out a coronavirus diagnosis.

Tips for Feeling Better

For allergies, there's actually a lot you can do to keep them in check. For instance, you may be able to reduce your allergy symptoms by lowering your exposure to the things that trigger them for you. In the spring and fall seasons that's often pollens ... but in the winter, it can be mold or other airborne substances.

Taking steps like these can help:

- Remove and discard shower curtains, wallpaper or carpeting that show evidence of mold.
- To help control dust mites and mold, use a dehumidifier to keep the humidity in your home below 50%.
- Use a HEPA air filter to clean dust from the air.
- Wash bedding in hot water (130° F) each week.
- Use allergen-proof covers on mattresses, pillows and comforters.
- If you have pet allergies, don't let your furry friends in the bedroom

- and give them a bath once a week to cut down on loose hair and dander.
- Don't place wood in the fireplace until you're ready to burn it, so pollens and mold stay outside.

In addition to these steps, you also can ask your doctor about over-thecounter and prescription medicines to help ease allergy symptoms.




